Dear Pet Owner,

Thank you for making the decision to spay or neuter your pet. GHS is not a private veterinary clinic. The services we offer are provided for individuals and families who would not otherwise be able to afford spaying and neutering services for their pets. If you do not meet the qualifications for the low cost option, you will pay the full cost option.

Funds for these services are augmented by private donations made to the Gastineau Humane Society's *Spay and Neuter Fund*, with the express purpose of helping Juneau pet owners who are in need of these services.

Please answer all of the questions on the form. After you have filled out the paperwork, our veterinary technician will contact you to schedule your pet's surgery.

General income guidelines for low cost eligibility are:

- ◆ **Single individual** – at or below \$1,749 per month
- ◆ **Couple** – at or below \$3,500 per month
- ◆ **Family of four** – at or below \$4,500 per month

Low Cost Option

Feline Neuter: \$65
Feline Spay: \$75
Canine Neuter: \$105
Canine Spay < 40 lbs: \$125
Canine Spay > 40 lbs: \$150

Full Cost Option

Feline Neuter: \$115
Feline Spay: \$125
Canine Neuter: \$155
Canine Spay < 40 lbs: \$175
Canine Spay > 40 lbs: \$200

Vaccinations: \$20 (i.e.: Rabies, Distemper/Parvo, and Feline Distemper)
Microchips: \$35

Spay/neuter fee includes: the surgery and immediate aftercare.

NOTE: There may be an extra charge if your animal is obese, in heat, or has undescended testicles. If your pet needs treatment for fleas, ear mites, or needs to be dewormed, treatment will be administered before proceeding with surgery. The cost of the medication needed to treat these issues will be added to the basic fee. To the extent possible, we will discuss this with you prior to surgery. Any extra costs that incur will need to be paid for when you pick up your pet after surgery.

All dogs must be currently licensed before leaving Gastineau Humane Society.
