By law all domestic animals are required to have a Rabies vaccination. If you cannot provide a current Rabies certificate at the time of surgery, we will require the vaccine at time of surgery. Additional costs apply.

Dear Pet Owner,

Thank you for making the responsible decision to spay/neuter your pet. Juneau Animal Rescue (JAR) is proud to offer Spaying and Neutering of public animals in our community. A veterinary clinic staff member will contact you to schedule your pet's surgery. Payment is required at the time of services. **OUT OF TOWN CLIENTS ARE REQUIRED TO PRE-PAY.**

A **\$20 licensing fee** is automatically added for all dogs over 6 months of age that are not currently licensed for a CBJ license; required by law. License tag(s) will be picked up with your dog after spay/neuter and rabies services are completed.

In order to receive the low-income qualified price, you must provide income verification documentation*. Low income guidelines are provided on the next page to see if you qualify.

****Due to the size of our facility, we cannot provide spaying for dogs over 70 pounds & have limited capacity for large dog neuters.**

JAR provides high-quality, high-volume (HQ-HV) spaying & neutering services to make the largest impact we can for animals in our community. Surgeries are performed under the ASPCA HQ-HV guidelines and while proven safe and effective, are not ideal for older animals, obese animals, or animals with some medical conditions. Modern techniques and trained staff will be used to care for all animals, and reasonable precautions will be used. However, animals will not have pre-operative bloodwork screening and intravenous catheters will not routinely be placed. This clinic is for young, healthy animals and is not appropriate for older animals or those with certain medical conditions. If your pet is elderly, obese, or has a known medical condition that might complicate their surgery, we recommend you seek spaying and neutering services with a private practitioner.

To ensure the security of your information, no copies of any income verification documentation will be kept by the Juneau Animal Rescue. Please do not mail or email income verification documents.*

NOTE: Prices are based on regular surgical protocols. There may be additional charges for any complications/treatments including but not limited to the following:

- Animal is obese, in heat, or pregnant
- Animal has undescended testicle(s)
- Animal is above listed weight ranges
- Animal needs flea, ear mite, or deworming treatment
- Emergency or Rescue procedures and medication

***To the extent possible, we will discuss any additional charges with you prior to surgery.**

Instructions for Spay/Neuter Surgery Candidates

Juneau Animal Rescue is proud to offer Spaying and Neutering of public animals in our community. Animals usually go home the day of surgery. However, on rare occasions, animals will stay overnight if medically necessary. You will be notified if this need arises.

Animals are **required to have a rabies vaccine prior to or at the time of surgery.**

Juneau Animal Rescue also recommends that your pet receive the following core vaccines:

Dogs: Distemper/Parvo/Leptospirosis (DHLPP), and Bordetella

Cats: FVRCP, FeLV.

Please provide proof of vaccinations to JAR along with your application or pay for the needed vaccines when providing payment to JAR. Vaccines will be administered at JAR after surgery.

Payment is REQUIRED before your animal is discharged from Juneau Animal Rescue.

Night Before Surgery:

- Pets cannot be fed before surgery.
- **NO FOOD & NO TREATS AFTER MIDNIGHT the night before, or the morning of surgery.**
- WATER IS OK until 6:00 A.M. on the day of surgery.

Day of Surgery:

- **Drop-off & pick-up animals at Juneau Animal Rescue, 7705 Glacier Highway, Juneau, AK 99801.**
- **SURGERY DROP-OFF IS AT 8AM- we are unable to admit surgery patients prior to this time.**
- Drop-Off and Pick-Up will be the **SAME DAY** as your pet's surgery.

To ensure the safety of your pet, cats need to be in a cat carrier when they enter Juneau Animal Rescue. If you need a carrier, JAR has cardboard carriers available for purchase. Dogs must be on a non-retractable leash.

Your pet will go home with after surgery care instructions, pain medication, and a vaccination certificate (if applicable).
